

Frequently Asked Questions (FAQs) – TOLF Ambassadors

Q. Who can become a TOLF Ambassador?

A. Anyone who registers for the program completes the volunteer application and on-boarding process can become a TOLF Ambassador.

Q. Is this open only to people in the Philadelphia area?

A. No, you don't have to live in Philadelphia. You can live anywhere in the U.S. and still participate. This is a great way to start planting seeds about the work our organization does and help us to bring our programs to your local area.

Q. How do I know what to say?

A. During the volunteer on-boarding process, you will be provided with a packet of information about our organization, mission and programs along with FAQs.

Q. How does the program participant referral work?

A. You can refer people to any of our regular programs. Regular programs are:

- Life Coaching
- Financial Literacy for Adults or Teens
- RISE Mentoring

Refer two (2) or more people to any of our regular programs, and once they complete 60% of their program, you will be qualified for a monthly prize or acknowledgement. (I inserted the monthly prizes and acknowledgements at the end of the sentence just to clarify what the credit they receive goes towards)

Refer five (5) or more people to the same workshop or class, with 60% (or 3 of the 5) of your referrals to attend and you will be qualified for a monthly prize or acknowledgement.

When they register for a regular program they can list your name as the referral in the comment box. Alternatively, you can send us an email of those you referred and we will confirm your attendees from the workshop sign in sheets, or have those you refer mention your name while signing to attend the workshop.

Q. How does the volunteer referral program work?

A. Refer three (3) people as volunteers, and once they are accepted and on-boarded, you'll receive credit.

Q. Where are your volunteers placed?

A. Volunteer opportunities may occur in our office, or at the facility of a partner organization that we support through providing our programs or workshops.

Q. What types of organizations does TOLF partner with?

A. We partner with organizations who typically work with under-served individuals and communities. The organizations we work with should have a mission that aligns with the work TOLF does, and must not have discriminatory practices or policies. We partner with schools (public, private and charter), government agencies and non-profit organizations and community groups.

Q. If I participate in the Ten for \$10 campaign, am I limited to getting donations in \$10 increments?

A. No, if you want to flex your fundraising muscles you can solicit donations in larger amounts.

Q. How will the funds from the Ten for \$10 campaign be used?

A. You can choose to sponsor a specific program(s) for your campaign or you can raise funds for miscellaneous use, according to our needs and program priorities. Funds raised from the Ten for \$10 campaign are NOT used for TOLF salaries.

Q. Are donations tax deductible?

A. All donations to TOLF are 100% tax deductible, under our IRS 501(c) (3) ruling. Please refer to the IRS for the complete ruling that applies to this tax exempt status [insert link here]

Q. Will I be compensated for participating as a TOLF Ambassador?

A. The One Less Foundation does not financially compensate its volunteers. All volunteers are eligible to receive various forms of thank you's, acknowledgement, and other prizes for volunteering.

Q. Can I use any crowd funding site to participate in the Ten for \$10 campaign?

A. We prefer the following crowd funding sites, as their fees to accept donations are low, which allows more of the actual donation to come to TOLF for program support.
